INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Village of Rhinebeck (Dutchess County, NY), hereinafter called the Owner, is soliciting bids, from qualified contractors for construction of two accessible crosswalks in the Village or Rhinebeck. One is located on West Market Street and the other is located on Route 9.

Receipt of Bids: Separate sealed bids will be received by the Village Clerk until **2 p.m. (local time) on Monday, May 19, 2014**. All bids must be made upon and in accordance with the form of proposals prepared by the Engineer, and shall be submitted in sealed envelopes so marked, "TWO ACCESSIBLE CROSSWALKS 2014".

It is strongly recommended that Bidders attend a **Pre-Bid Site Visit** with the Engineer at 2 p.m. on Thursday, May 8, 2014 on East Market Street at Garden Street, Rhinebeck, NY 12572.

The Bidding Documents, including Bidding Requirements and Contract Documents will be available at the Office of the Village Clerk, 76 E. Market St., Rhinebeck, NY 12572, telephone (845) 876-7015.

Each bid shall be accompanied by an acceptable form of Bid Deposit Guarantee, in an amount equal to at least five (5) percent of the amount of the Bid, payable to the Owner as guarantee that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute the Contract and file acceptable Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds within five (5) days after the award of the Contract.

The Bid Deposit shall be in the form of a Certified Check, or a Bid Bond on the form of Bid Bond presented within the Bid Requirements, and be drawn payable to the Owner.

Bids will be considered by the Owner. If award is to proceed to the Successful Bidder, it will be on, or around Tuesday, May 20, 2014. Contract execution is to proceed within 10 days of award in order to quickly move towards completion. The Work is to be Complete by the end of August 2014.

OWNER'S RIGHTS RESERVED: The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formality or technicality in any Bid in the interest of the Owner.

STATEMENT OF NON-COLLUSION: Bidders are required to execute the non-collusion bidding certificate presented within the Bid Requirements, pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

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Bidders are also required to comply with the provision of Section 291-299 of the Executive Law of the State of New York.

The Owner hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in regard to any Contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for any award.
