Mayor Tortarella opened the meeting at 6:30 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Please take notice that at the Special Board meeting of the Village Board of Trustees, for the Village of Rhinebeck, N.Y. held on January 15th, 2015 the following resolution was offered by Mayor Heath Tortarella and seconded by Trustee Heinz Sauer and unanimously adopted.

The next general Village election for officers will be held on Wednesday, March 18th, 2015. No person shall be entitled to vote in this election unless they are registered with the County Board of Elections and on the County Voter Registration list. Residents of the Village of Rhinebeck must register with the County Board of Elections by March 6th, 2015 to be included on the county list for the March 18th, 2015 Village election. If you are already registered with the county at your current address, you do not have to register with the county again to vote. The Village of Rhinebeck no longer holds a Village Registration Day.

Voting for the forthcoming election shall be conducted Wednesday, March 18th, 2015 from noon to 9:00pm, at the Rhinebeck Town Hall, 80 East Market St., Rhinebeck, N.Y. The Town Hall is handicapped accessible.

The remainder of the special meeting was a budget workshop and addressed by Treasurer Karen McLaughlin.

With no further business to be brought before the Board, Mayor Tortarella made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Deputy Mayor Traudt and all the board present was in favor.

Trustee Kenton made a motion to approve Griffin pump as receiving the bid on the Astor Home Pump station repairs. The motion was second by Trustee Cruikshank and all the Board present was in favor.
